Be sure to read the question carefully and read all the answers carefully before marking your selection. Be sure to review the entire examination to make sure that you did not skip any pages or questions.

ASSE will grade the exam and forward the score to your school. A score of seventy (70%) percent or better shall be considered a passing grade.
